SB 59, Revise laws related to integrated least-cost resource planning, Senator McNally (D-Billings) Senate Energy, Executive Action, Support. SB 59 would allow utilities to submit Resource Procurement Plans every two or three years instead of the current legal requirement to do so every three years. SB 85, Generally revise taxation of renewable energy, <u>Senator Ankney (R-Colstrip) Senate Taxation, Executive Action, Oppose</u>. SB 85 would raise taxes on wind energy generation. SB 98, Revising laws related to grizzly bear take in defense of persons and livestock, Senator Gillespie (R-Ethridge) Senate Agriculture, Executive Action, Oppose. The language would replace language approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to assure adequate mechanisms to maintain grizzly bears post delisting from the endangered species list, and ensure that grizzlies are never delisted in Montana.
